YOU HAVE BEEN ISSUED A CITATION THAT CHARGES YOU WITH THE VIOLATION OF ONE OR MORE TRAFFIC LAWS. READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

INSTRUCTIONS:

On your citation, you have been given a date on which you must make a court appearance before the Springville Justice Court Judge.

If a date is not specified you must appear not less that 5 or more than 14 days from the date you receive your ticket. (see Judges court hours listed above)

If you fail to appear or post bail on this charge you may be charged with Failure to Appear. Failure to Appear is a misdemeanor and is separate from the charge written on the citation. A person may be found guilty of failure to appear regardless of the outcome of the original charge(s).

- Upon appearance in the court, you may see the Judge and
1. **Enter a plea of "GUILTY"**. If you enter a plea of guilty you may make a statement prior to being sentenced by the Court. Pay fine imposed by the Court.
 2. **Enter a plea of "NOT GUILTY"**. A date and time for trial will be set and a formal notice of trial will be mailed to you. You may be required to post bail until the trial date. If you lose your case, you must be prepared to pay the fine at the conclusion of the trial.
 3. **Enter a plea of "NO CONTEST"**. No admission of guilt, you do not want a trial and will pay the fine imposed by the Court, you may make a statement prior to being sentenced. You must obtain permission from the Judge to enter this plea.

ALTERNATIVE TO APPEARING IN COURT

You may clear this citation by posting bail with the clerk, (see business hours above) or by mailing to the court the amount of bail listed below for the offense(s) as shown on your citation.

If the offense(s) does not appear below, you must appear before the Judge. (see Judge's Court hours above).

By using the alternative to appearing in court you must understand that:

1. You have waived your right to a day in court.
2. The bail will be applied to your case.
3. Your case will be recorded as a conviction.
4. The Drivers License Division will be notified of the conviction when so required by statute.

REMEMBER

If you intend to enter a NOT GUILTY PLEA, you must appear in person as directed. Whichever action you choose must be done not less than 5 or more than 14 days from the date you received the citation.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

You have the option of paying by check, cash, credit or debit cards.

You can pay in person at the Springville Justice Court with cash, check, credit or debit card. Please stop at the Court Clerk's office for a payment slip with your case number. (Payment counter is open Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)

You may also call the court and pay over the phone with a credit or debit card. The phone number is 801-489-2707.

The Court business hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00p.m., Monday through Friday. (Closed on holidays.)

Note: Failure to make your payment as ordered by the Court can result in additional penalties being imposed.

Please include your case number with each payment to make sure that your payment gets credited to the right account. If you have more than one case number, include each case number.

ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF INSURANCE:

A violation of "No Proof of Insurance" can be dismissed when verification in the form of a letter is presented to the Court with the following required information.

1. Letter on Insurance Agency letterhead
2. Name of insured, if the name of the insured is different than the person who received the citation, the letter must include an explanation indicating that the driver had permission of the owner and is covered under that policy.
3. Vehicle description (must match the vehicle on the citation.)
4. Coverage was in effect on the date and time the citation was issued.
5. Agents signature
6. Citation or Case Number.
